1. Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting

To collaborate with Shires across the Murray Darling Basin to influence outcomes in water and the circular economy.

2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

The Federal Minister for Environment and Water, The Hon Tanya Plibersek MP, the Federal Shadow Minister for Water, Senator Perin Davey as well as the outgoing Murray Darling Basin Authority (MDBA) Executive Director River Management, Mr Andrew Reynolds were all in attendance.

MDA Board Chairs and Member representatives reflected on current and ongoing issues and points of interest within the Murray-Darling Basin (the Basin), with a strong focus on the Federal Government's progressing plans regarding water purchasing program.

During the meeting with Federal Minister for Environment and Water, the Hon Tanya Plibersek an update was provided on the Association's advocacy on the Water Amendment (Restoring our Rivers) Bill 2023, which included 11 recommendations for Federal Government.

The Minister indicated that the Federal Government was well underway into addressing the recommendations to meet water demands with less water, and to reduce non-riparian Local Government reliance on the Murray-Darling Basin, with \$103M included in the last budget to redo the science to address the changing climate, as well as through the Resilient Rivers program.

While the Minister indicated that over-recovered water from the Macquarie Valley did not count towards any of the currently standing targets, I was able to provide an alternate use for the water, being that if it cannot be returned to the Macquarie Valley, that it be utilised for Indigenous, or cultural heritage purposes. Minister Plibersek had indicated that this utilisation of water had not been considered. The Minister also indicated that the bulk of water purchasing will need to come from the south, as that is where the bulk of the water is.

3. Benefits to Narromine Shire Council

Advancing with water and circular economy opportunities in the Narromine Shire.

4. Suggestions for Future Action (if appropriate)

Maintain an active role in this organisation, and as a member of the Executive Team, to provide advice in relation to local and regional water issues and to enhance outcomes.
