#### 1. Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting

Main purpose of the meeting was to continue the positive role of the AWC in advocating for better outcomes for the member councils.

### 2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

Presentation by Murray Darling Basin Authority highlighting the importance of State-Federal engagement as well as the importance of Critical Human Needs Water in the Northern Basin Plan.

CEO of RDA addressed the Designated Area Migration Agreement (DAMA) issue and its expansion across other RDA's and gave an update on Golden Highway upgrades.

Dept Regional Economic Development spoke to the issues they can help councils with including introduction of businesses for development. Topics included Agrifood Clean Economy, Technology, Regional Indigenous partnerships and the Circular Economy.

Member for the Dubbo Electorate, Mr Dugald Saunders MP, spoke on water issues, crime initiatives, rural airstrip grants and migration issues.

Telstra representative addressed issues surrounding introduction of 5G and the shutdown of 3G. All Shires indicated they have been seriously impacted with poorer service.
