All rate paying residents should have received their tip tokens recently. The tip tokens can be used to dispose of general waste loads for **FREE** at Narromine, Trangie and Tomingley Waste Facilities. Please note all waste must be sorted, otherwise the usual fees will be charged. Tokens are not transferable, cannot be used for cash and are not refundable. The token system entitles the owner of a residential property within the Narromine Shire area to two (2) waste disposal tokens. Tokens are issued one per year. **Landlords and property managers are encouraged to pass tokens on to their tenants.**

The community is asked to rank the four proposed locations in priority from 1 (most preferred) to 4 (least preferred). PUBLIC EXHIBITION – ROAD NAMES AT NARROMINE AVIATION BUSINESS PARK

Council resolved at its monthly meeting held on 8 July 2020 to approve the following street names for the new Narromine Aviation Business Park development at Narromine Aerodrome, Mitchell Highway, Narromine.

The three preferred names for roads 1, 2 and 3 respectively are; Powell, Hayden and Pay. If any of these names should not be suitable, or other names are required at a later time at the Aerodrome Precinct the alternatives to be considered are Johnston, Coomber and Butler. Please note that following the public exhibition period, Council will select the road type (i.e. Street, Alley etc) to ensure it complies with the criteria under AS/NZS 4819:2011.
