PUBLIC NOTICE - CLASSIFICATION OF LAND NARROMINE

Council has previously resolved that upon purchase of 2.665 hectares of part Lot 22 DP 538206 (now registered as Lot 200 DP 127166) for the continued use of drainage, the land be classified as operational land.

REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMIT AT NARROMINE RAILWAY LEVEL CROSSINGS

Council advises that from **Wednesday 28 April 2021**, speed limits at level crossings along the **Inland Rail route** will reduced to a maximum of 80km/h.

Transport for NSW advises that new specially designed speed zone signs will be installed about 400 metres from the level crossings along **The McGrane Way** (**Tullamore Road**) and **Tomingley West Road** in the Narromine Shire local government area.

NSW Transport has developed a policy to reduce the speed limit from 100 km/h to 80 km/h at level crossings controlled by boom gates and flashing lights to lower the risks of collisions.

This new speed zone around level crossings along the **Inland Rail route** in Narromine and Parkes local government areas will **be the first in the Central West** to be reduced, in a bid to improve safety. ARTC NARROMINE RAIL MAINTENANCE WORK

Council advises that Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will carry out maintenance work in Narromine during May to replace a component of rail track (sleepers). This maintenance work is scheduled to take place from **7.00 am to 5.00 pm** from **Thursday 13 May to Sunday 16 May 2021**.

On Thursday 13 May traffic control will guide road users through changed traffic conditions at the **Dandaloo Street level crossing**.

The pedestrian crossing will be closed for the duration of the day. There will be an alternate route for pedestrians. Please note that the information provided by ARTC is subject to change due to the unplanned or unexpected event such as operational changes or heavy rain. NOTICE OF AIRBORNE SURVEY

Council advises that FMG Resources Pty Ltd (Fortescue) will be conducting an airborne geophysical survey commencing at the end of May 2021.

The survey will cover the areas south of Trangie to Peak Hill and south of Trundle. The survey will be conducted in daylight hours, seven days a week, with a fixed-wing aircraft flying at 50 metres above the ground in 100 metre spaced lines. HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEAN OUT

Council wishes to advise all residents that **the 2021 Chemical Clean Out** will be taking place on **Sunday 23 May 2021** where residents will be able to dispose of unwanted or expired household chemicals for free, including hazardous chemicals such as: garden chemicals, swimming pool chemicals, household cleaners, hobby chemicals, poisons, batteries, paint, motor oils, fluids and fuels, fluorescent lights, gas bottles, fire extinguishers and smoke detectors. All containers **MUST** be secure with lids.

Collection will take place **on Sunday 23 May 2021** at Trangie Waste Facility, Trangie Tip Road from **8.00 am until 11.00 am** and at Narromine Waste Facility, Gainsborough Road from **1.00 pm until 4.00 pm**.

Pedestrians are advised to enter the Wetlands with caution, as internal walkway closures will occur. For your safety, please observe all signs in place.
