#### **Executive Summary**

A request has been received from the Trangie Amateur Swimming Club for a waiver of fees, provision of lifeguard and retention of gate takings for their annual swimming carnival to be hosted on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

#### Report

The Trangie Amateur Swimming Club has hosted an annual swimming carnival for a number of years which encourages children within the Western Area to compete for rankings to qualify for larger competitions.

To host this carnival, a \$200 hire fee is applicable and the pool is closed to the public for the day. Council supplies a junior staff member for the day, who has the responsibility of taking gate entry fees, cleaning and restocking facilities, and ensuring the grounds are kept clean and tidy. The Club is responsible for providing their own qualified lifeguard for the day.

In 2017, Council supported the Trangie Amateur Swimming Club by paying for two committee members to obtain a lifeguard qualification at a cost of \$980. This was to ensure that in cases such as these, the club would be able to meet the terms and conditions of hire. Should the club not be able to provide their own lifeguard, labour hire is available as per Council's 2018-2019 Fees & Charges, a cost of \$40 per hour.

The Trangie Amateur Swimming Club has submitted an application under the donations, sponsorships & waiver of fees and charges policy for the following:

- Waiver of the \$200 Trangie pool carnival hire fee
- Provision of one lifeguard for the day (12 hours x \$40 = \$480)
- The Trangie Amateur Swimming Club to collect and retain all gate takings for the day (unknown value).

The application is provided to Council under separate cover.

Council staff met with the Trangie Amateur Swimming Club on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2018 to discuss their application. The club requested that the provision of a lifeguard be removed from the application as they have sourced their own lifeguard for the event.

The Trangie Amateur Swimming Club receive income from registered swimmers, who are required to pre-register online and pay a set fee for each competition race.

There are three options to consider:

- 1. Council meet the requests of the swimming club, at a financial cost to Council of at least \$650 (based on 100 patrons entering the facility).
- 2. Council provide a contribution to the Trangie Amateur Swimming Club equal to the swimming pool admission fees collected from all pre-registered swimmers (\$4.00 each), as well as one supporting non-swimming adult attending the carnival (\$2.50 each). All swimmers are registered for the carnival through Swimming NSW and this is public information. This would support the continuation of the club carnival, as well as avoid setting a precedent for Council gate takings to be retained by community groups. Total cost estimated at \$325 (based on 100 patrons entering the facility).
- 3. Council does not support the application as the club is financially viable.

## **Financial Implications**

Loss of income from hire fees and gate takings.

## Legal and Regulatory Compliance

Section 377(q) of the Local Government Act 1993 - Financial assistance under section 356 cannot be delegated.

#### Risk Management Issues

A lifeguard is required for the carnival (this is being provided by the club). Council will need to consider the ramifications of setting a precedent if it allows retention of the gate takings.
