FOOD & GARDEN WASTE BIN



ALL FOOD SCRAPS

Fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, bones, eggs and dairy, tea leaves, teabags, coffee grounds, bread, rice, pasta, left-overs, expired food



SOILED PAPER & CARDBOARD

Paper towel, tissues, pizza boxes



GARDEN ORGANICS

Grass clippings, flowers and weeds, prunings and branches (up to 15cm diameter)



CADDY LINERS

ONLY council provided cornstarch caddy liners

RECYCLING BIN



STEEL, TIN, ALUMINIUM CANS

including empty aerosols



CARDBOARD

Clean boxes, milk & juice cartons



GLASS

Bottles and jars, rinsed and lids off



CLEAN PAPER

Newspaper, magazines, paper, junk mail, window envelopes



HARD PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS

Yoghurt & ice-cream, water & soft drink, milk, shampoo, detergent, sunscreen, empty with lids off

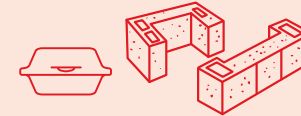


GLASS
