State of the Environment

A State of the Environment (SoE) Report is an important management tool which aims to provide the community and Local Council with information on the condition of the environment in the local area to assist in decision-making.

Since 2007, the Councils of the Greater Central West Region of NSW (see map) have joined to produce Regional SoE Reports as part of Council reporting requirements.

Changes to NSW legislation mean that Councils are no longer required to produce SoE Reports each year, but only once every four years, in the year of the Council election. However, the participating Councils have decided to continue reporting on an annual basis so that they can provide a detailed Regional SoE report that covers trends in the intervening years.

This is a brief snapshot of data for the Narromine Local Government Area in 2016-17 across a range of environmental indicators as shown in the tables below. The tables provide an understanding of trends by comparing this year's data with an average of previous years. The Council snapshot report should be read in conjunction with the 2016-17 Regional SoE report.

2016-17 Highlights

- In 2016-17, there were no drinking water complaints to Council and no instances when drinking water standards were not met.
- There was an increase in the use of the metered water supply compared with the past two years.
- There was a significant increase in the volume of material recycled per person compared with last year.
- Council used less paper in 2016-17 than in the previous three years.
- The annual electricity consumption for Council controlled HA facilities was less than the previous two years.
