1. Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting Quarterly Meeting

## 2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

- Update provided by Transport for NSW in relation to major projects that are underway in the region, along with natural disasters, fixing local roads and fixing country bridges.
- Update provided from Rebecca Fox, Secretary Department of Regional NSW in relation to Biodiversity Offset Scheme and Regional Drought Resilience Planning Programs designed to provide support to identified regions in NSW and to develop plans that can be implemented by councils to manage future drought risks.
