1. Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting

2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

- a) John St house destroyed by fire has been inspected. Council continuing to deal with the problem.
- b) Council Community Meetings – Update from Kelly: the meetings have been going really well - community feedback has been very constructive (negative and positive). Has initiated inspections around town e.g. drainage, footpaths etc. Pushes issues through the system every month.
- c) Disabled Parking – Results from the Community Consultation Survey to go to Traffic Committee, anticipated completion before the end of the year.
- d) Surveys for community consultations will be moved onto the Council homepage in the future to improve accessibility.
- e) Trangie Memorial Pool – the black sign isn't intended to stand out, it's intentionally black.
