Executive Summary

This report is presented to Council to consider entering into a lease for the Dandaloo road north end area (approximately 501.05m²) within the rail corridor near the Trangie Truck Stop for stormwater purposes.

As part of Council's stormwater improvement program, and to preserve the road asset, upgrades to the stormwater system have been identified at the entrance of the Trangie Truck Stop. Part of the upgrade includes the installation of culverts within the rail corridor (See Attachment No. 2)

Discussions held with John Holland Group and the subsequent approvals processes indicated that Council would be required to pay a license fee of \$1,100.00 (incl. GST) per annum. The network operations will be handed over to UGL Regional Linx along with the agreement between Council and John Holland.

Alternative designs for the stormwater system were considered, but due to the location it would require significant capital investment for the construction of a drainage structure to consider heavy vehicle loads (including the potential of loads to shift during transport) and turning conditions at the entrance of the Trangie Truck Stop.

Financial Implications

Council will be required to pay an annual license fee of \$1,100.00 (incl. GST) which will be subject to rise and fall adjustments.

Legal and Regulatory Compliance

A long-term lease agreement between John Holland Group/UGL Regional Linx and Council will need to be entered into for the purposes of asset maintenance and drainage.

Approval in Principal has been obtained from John Holland Group.

Risk Management Issues

Alternative designs for the stormwater system were considered, but due to the location it would require significant capital investment for the construction of a drainage structure to consider heavy vehicle loads (including the potential of loads to shift during transport) and turning conditions at the entrance of the Trangie Truck Stop.






