INTRODUCTION OF ANNUAL PERMITS FOR NON-DESEXED CATS AND DANGEROUS/RESTRICTED DOGS

The NSW Government is introducing annual permits for non-desexed cats and restricted and dangerous dogs as part of its commitment to promoting responsible pet ownership and improving animal welfare standards. From 1 July 2020 owners of cats not desexed by four months of age will be required to pay an \$80 annual permit in addition to their one-off lifetime pet registration fee.

It's simple to avoid them – just register your cat before 1 July and choose a non-restricted dog breed. Find out more:

PESTICIDE USE NOTIFICATION - PRIORITY WEED CONTROL

In accordance with Part 5 of the Pesticide Regulation 2017, Narromine Shire Council wishes to inform the community of the following pesticide are used by staff on Council property. (Please note the time periods indicate the planned duration, but activities may occasionally occur outside each period). Council will be performing weed control from 1 July 2020 to 30 December 2020 in the following locations.

- Urban and rural road & laneway veraes
- Drains & other easements
- Macquarie & Bogan River foreshores
- Sporting Ovals
- Council Parks and gardens
- Cemeteries
- Reserves
- Council assets (land)

Council are controlling the following weeds; African Boxthorn, Bathurst & Noogoora Burr, Galvanised Burr, Johnson Grass, Tiger Pear, Coolatai Grass, Green Cestrum, St Johns Wort, Bridal Creeper, Silverleaf Nightshade, Spiny Burr Grass, Blue Heliotrope. All broad leaf pests relating to Parks and Garden activities

The follow products are being used;

• Grazon Extra (300 g/L Triclopyr, 100 g/L Picloram, 8 g/L Aminopyralid)

- Safari 600EC (600 g/L Triclopyr)
- Pulse (1020 g/L Polyether modified polysiloxane)
- Enviro Dye (Diazo Dyestuff)
- Wipe-out Accelerate (540 g/L Glyphosate)
- Brushoff (600g/kg Metsulfuron-methyl)
- 2-4D Amine 625 (625g/L 2-4D Present as Dimethylamine and DiethanolamineSalts)

Note: Signage will be displayed whilst application is taking place and will remain there until the re-entry period has expired (if applicable) in accordance with the Narromine Shire Councils Pesticide Use Notification Plan.
