**CROWN LANDS PLANS OF MANAGEMENT ON PUBLIC EXHIBITION**

The Narromine Shire community is invited to make submissions on Narromine Shire Council's management of community land including parks, sportsgrounds and public spaces.

**Plans of Management** have now been developed for all Crown and Council-owned community land within the Narromine Shire Local Government Area. These Plans of Management outline the features of the community and clarifies how Council will manage, use or develop the land in the future.

**HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEAN OUT**

Council wishes to advise all residents that **the 2021 Chemical Clean Out** will be taking place on **Sunday 23 May 2021** where residents will be able to dispose of unwanted or expired household chemicals for free, including hazardous chemicals such as: garden chemicals, swimming pool chemicals, household cleaners, hobby chemicals, poisons, batteries, paint, motor oils, fluids and fuels, fluorescent lights, gas bottles, fire extinguishers and smoke detectors. All containers **MUST** be secure with lids.

Collection will take place **on Sunday 23 May 2021** at Trangie Waste Facility, Trangie Tip Road from **8.00 am until 11.00 am** and at Narromine Waste Facility, Gainsborough Road from **1.00 pm until 4.00 pm**.

**NARROMINE WETLANDS REMAINS CLOSED TO ALL VEHICLES**

Council advises all residents that the Narromine Wetlands is closed to **all vehicles** as construction of the first primary pond is underway. **Pedestrians** are able to access the Wetlands via the pedestrian gate near the public toilets.

Pedestrians are advised to enter the Wetlands **with caution**, as internal walkway closures will occur. For your safety, please observe all signs in place.

The **expansion and development** of the Narromine Wetlands has been made available as a result of funding received by Narromine Shire Council from the NSW Government's **Regional Growth Environment and Tourism Fund**.

#### **ROAD SAFETY REMINDER**

Council advises that the following roads remain closed to all vehicles: **McLeods Lane, Tyrie North Road** and **Merrinong Road** (between and Pineview and Ewenmar Roads). The remainder of unsealed roads are open to all vehicles. **All motorists are reminded not to drive through floodwaters** and proceed with caution on all other roads.
