## **NOTICE OF AIRBORNE SURVEY**

Council advises that **FMG Resources Pty Ltd (Fortescue)** will be conducting an airborne geophysical survey commencing at the end of May 2021.

The survey will cover the areas south of Trangie to Peak Hill and south of Trundle. The survey will be conducted in daylight hours, seven days a week, with a fixed-wing aircraft flying at 50 metres above the ground in 100 metre spaced lines. Pedestrians are advised to enter the Wetlands with caution, as internal walkway closures will occur. For your safety, please observe all signs in place.

The **expansion and development** of the Narromine Wetlands has been made available as a result of funding received by Narromine Shire Council from the NSW Government's **Regional Growth Environment and Tourism Fund**.
