NARROMINE SHIRE COUNCIL SERVICES - COVID SAFE

Narromine Shire Council Customer Service and Payments Centre, 118 Dandaloo Street, re-opened on Monday 11 October 2021. Due to current legislation only fully vaccinated people and/or those with medical exemptions are to be permitted entry. Narromine Sports and Fitness Centre re-opened on Monday 11 October 2021. Due to current legislation only fully vaccinated people and those with medical exemptions will be permitted entry. Persons aged under 16 years of age who are unvaccinated may enter but must be in presence of a vaccinated member of the same household.

All memberships to the **Narromine Sports and Fitness Centre** are considered **inactive** until such time members provide Council with a copy of vaccination certificate or medical exemption. Please forward proof of vaccination or medical exemption to **mail@narromine.nsw.gov.au** or drop certificates into Narromine Shire Council Customer Services and Payments Centre, 118 Dandaloo Street, during business hours 8.30 am - 5.00 pm weekdays. Please note membership activation can only take place during Council's business hours of 8.30 am - 5.00 pm Monday – Friday.

Community members will be welcomed back to the Narromine and Trangie Libraries from **Monday 25 October 2021, for regular opening hours.** Please visit the Macquarie Regional Library website <u>https://www.mrl.nsw.gov.au/</u> to confirm exact hours of operations and conditions of entry, as conditions are subject to change under the NSW Public Health Order.

SWIMMING SEASON COMMENCES

Narromine's Aquatic Centre will open this Saturday 23 October at 10.00 am, whilst Trangie's Aquatic Centre has been operating all week. Joint pool season tickets (for use at both Narromine and Trangie) are available for purchase at the aquatic centre venues only. Due to public health orders, all Aquatic Centre staff and visitors will have to adhere to the COVID – 19 safety protocols put in place by Lifeguarding Services Australia (LSA). This includes entry using QR codes and evidence of COVID – 19 vaccinations, whilst anyone with a medication exemption must also provide evidence, all children under the age of 12 years of age must be accompanied by a vaccinated adult.

COVID -19 TESTING CLINICS IN NARROMINE AND TRANGIE

Council advises residents that **NSW Health** is conducting a drive-through COVID-19 testing clinic at Narromine Hospital from 9.30 am through to 2.30 pm each day. NSW Health runs a testing clinic at Trangie's MPS, please call 5881 9200 to secure an appointment.

Surveillance testing is now activated across the Western NSW Local Health District and this allows residents to be tested and not have to self-isolate after the test is conducted - unless you have symptoms; you have been directed to isolate by NSW Health or have been at a venue of concern or someone in your household is a close contact of a confirmed COVID – 19 case.

CLOSED ROADS AND ROAD SAFETY REMINDER

The following roads will remain **CLOSED to ALL VEHICLES** - Gainsborough Road (between Tomingley Road and McGrane Way) and Pinedene Road remain closed.

All motorists are reminded not to drive through floodwaters and proceed with caution on all other roads.
