## ROAD SAFETY REMINDERS OVER HARVEST

Over harvest, all roads users are reminded to be cautious:

- Heavy vehicles may move slowly, take care and be patient.
- Don't try and overtake until it is safe.
- If you see a pilot vehicle, it means an oversize vehicle is approaching. Prepare to slow down and change your lane position. Oversize vehicles need additional room.
- Oversize vehicles have blind spots and may not see you. Take extra care.
- Heavy vehicles may have trailers attached and can be longer than expected. Take care when changing lanes.
- If you can, share the driving to prevent fatigue crashes.

## FLOOD WATER and ROAD SAFETY

All motorists are reminded **not to drive through floodwaters** and proceed with caution on all other roads. Council reminds all motorists to check Council's website, social media and LiveTraffic app or call 132 701 for information on local roads and traffic.
