WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION – SUNDAY 22 MAY 2022

Council advises residents in the following locations of **Alagalah Street, Meryula Street, Temoin Street and Terangion Street**, Narromine that there will be a planned interruption to the water supply on **Sunday 22 May 2022** from **10.00 am – 2.00 pm**. This interruption is due to an emergency repair, residents and businesses are requested to ensure that they have ample water in reserve to cover their requirements during this **interruption to service**.

In addition to the above-mentioned locations, residents in the general vicinity may experience a **drop in pressure and water discolouration during and up to 24 hours** following interruption. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to residents.

Motorists are advised to drive with caution, as these works will be undertaken at as to minimise inconvenience to road users. Lane closures and traffic controllers may be utilised for the duration of the works. Minor delays may be experienced.

CONSTRUCTION WORKS PLANNED FROM 23 MAY 2022

Council advises residents in **Murgah and Short Streets** that underground drilling and open trench excavation will commence in this location from **23 May until 20 June 2022**. There may be some access restrictions to properties during this time, those affected residents have been advised accordingly by Robson Civil Projects. This project will construct the rising sewer main for the Dappo Road and Timbrebongie residential subdivisions.
