The site will be fenced off for safety during this time.

PUBLIC EXHIBITION - UPDATED DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL

INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (Manufacture of unmanned aerial vehicles (Drones) and 2 lot subdivision of Narromine Aerodrome, 7 March to 31 March 2022.

Description of Development

Subdivision of the Narromine Aerodrome to allow sale of approximately 21 Ha of land to the developer for the proposal, at the western section of the Aerodrome.

1. The development has been amended after previous exhibition and consideration of submissions. The industrial building is relocated to avoid conflict with grassed runway 11. The proposed subdivided lot area has reduced in total area.

- 2. The proposal seeks to establish an industrial manufacturing premises with associated office/amenities.
- 3. The development will involve a new approx. 2000m2 industrial shed for UAV assembly and storage of material for production output.
- 4. Proposed products include: Unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) and related drone products Associated meters and instrumentation Materials handling equipment Spare parts.
- 5. The overall development will see the construction of a building, laydown areas, parking and staff amenity for the development allowing the employment of ten (10) staff.

The site does not have access to town water and sewer services, and as such, has proposed onsite effluent disposal and rainwater tanks. The subject Development Application and supporting Plans are on display for a period of 14 days from 17 March 2023 – 31 March 2023, online at https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.gu/daexhibitions
